SUMMARY

Victor Morales

- ∞ Victor Morales began deforesting and plowing roads for what we believe is infrastructure to support an illegal segregation in the ecologically sensitive Mt. Resaca watershed in violation of protective zoning.
- ∞ He has caused serious harm carving steep roads perpendicular to the Resaca river bed and building a dirt bridge directly across river bed.
- ∞ To our knowledge there are no ARPE permits for this segregation.
- ∞ No public hearing have been held and there is no EIS as required by the 1999 coral law.
- ∞ In an attempt to prevent further damage, after filing formal complaints with the DRNA, Dec 21, 2007 - QC-41-07, CORALations also telephoned Secretary Javier Vélez Arocho, and then received an email communication directly from the Secretary of DRNA that indicated the project was referred to their legal division.

- ∞ Photo journals were kept online, with information about formal complaints filed an observed impacts.
